Requirements:

1. This form must be returned to Joan Waldron at least 90 days prior to the start of the horse show for publication in our newsletter. Any request not made in a timely fashion will not be honored.
2. You will be notified whether or not your horse show has been approved for **ESQHA** year-end award points.
3. Show results are to be forwarded to **Joan Waldron within two weeks from the last day of the horse show.**
4. You must be willing to accept ESQHA memberships at the show and post our rules about year-end awards. Any memberships received at the show must be forwarded to our club secretary within two weeks of the end of the horse show.
5. Horse show results must be submitted in electronic format for all pointed shows. Directions are attached for putting the results into a file that can either be emailed or posted so the results can be downloaded from an **ftp** site.
6. If results are not submitted electronically, there will be a \$15 charge per judge to get the results from AQHA.
7. Please e-mail results to regina@niagara.edu for youth point keeping and joanwaldron@msn.com for adult point keeping. If results are posted, you need to email that the results are available to download and give any directions to be able to download the results.

Horse Show Point Rules

ESQHA year-end awards are based on the members acquiring the most horse-show points from approved ESQHA shows, in the year beginning January 1st thru October 31.

1. Points will be kept on horses belonging to ESQHA members only. Please make sure that the OWNER of the horse has a current membership. All owners and riders must have current AQHA memberships.
2. Memberships must be paid in full to the secretary prior to any points being kept. The postmark date will denote the date the membership is received. Farms are considered to be a “family membership,” and dues should be paid accordingly. NOTE: Youth memberships must also acquire ESQHA membership to be eligible for ESQHA year-end awards.
3. Only shows that are ESQHA approved (listed in the newsletter) will count toward year-end awards.
4. A member must receive points in at least five (5) approved shows per event before becoming eligible for an award. If any class is not offered in at least five approved shows, no award will be given.
5. All ESQHA approved shows and Special Events will count for points.
6. Halter horses standing Grand Champion at halter at AQHA approved shows will receive one (1) more point than any other horse in his/her sex division, regardless of age.
7. Halter horses standing Reserve Champion at halter at AQHA approved shows will receive one-half point more than any other horse in his/her sex division, regardless of age, except the Grand Champion for that sex division.
8. Year-end awards will be presented at the ESQHA Convention.
9. All state points received by ESQHA members from the ESQHA or ESQHVA shows will be doubled for year-end awards

Directions for Making an Association disk using CyberTech, Inc. Horse Show System Software DOS version

1. Select a show
 - Master Files → Shows → Work with New Show → Select one of the shows and press enter
 - Press ESC twice to get back to the main menus
2. Select More
3. Select Utilities
4. Select Association Disk Creation
5. Select **State Association**
6. Insert a new disk in your 3.5" disk drive and press Enter
 - Put in your drive letter for output (Usually A)
 - Country Code for NON-US = CN
 - Press N for No more Changes
7. The program will write out the report and tell you when it is done.
8. Press ESC when done
9. Repeat steps 1 – 8 for each AQHA show. E.g. usually a weekend of showing counts as two AQHA shows. One show would be Saturday and the other would be Sunday.

Please note:

- On the disk will be a file called Shwrslt. If there is a file called Roster you chose AQHA instead of State in step 5. **If Shwrslt is not on the disk please try again and make sure you choose State Association on step 5.**
- Please return extra disks and labels
- Label the disks with the date of the show
- Use one disk for each show (usually one day of showing)
- Please notify me of any disqualification from AQHA

You can email the shwrslt file. Just rename the file to the date of the show or the AQHA show number and send it as a file attachment to regina@niagara.edu
