**From the East or West:** From the New York State Thruway (I-90), take exit 39 (Route 690). Follow Route 690 East to Exit 7 (Fairgrounds / Route 297). At the end of the exit, stay right onto Route 297. Make an immediate left turn into Fairgrounds Gate 2.

**From the North or South:** Follow Route 81. Follow signs to exit on Route 690 West and exit Route 690 at the Fairgrounds (Exit 39).

# 2010 Empire Fall Show

## General Information

1. Move in / Move Out: Horses cannot arrive prior to Noon on Tuesday, September 21 and must move out no later than 9:00 a.m. on Monday, September 27.
2. Payments: Stall, camper and entry fees must be paid when submitting reservations. Without payment, NO reservations will be accepted. You may enter a minimum of one class per horse to avoid post entry late charges. Additional classes may be entered during the show at the regular class fee. Any entry scratched from a class and not reported to the show office will be charged the class fee. Scratches reported to the show office will not be charged the class fee.
3. Entries: Entries close on Wednesday September 8, 2010. Any entry postmarked after that date will be considered a post entry. Post entries will be accepted with a \$25 computer late charge per horse. Please send a legible copy of the horse's current AQHA registration papers, AQHA & NSBA membership cards and required health papers with your entry. [See paragraph 21 for health requirements]
4. Stalls: Stalls will be labeled with stall card when you arrive. No transfer of stalls or change of occupancy may be made without the approval of the show management. Exhibitors will be charged for the use of ANY stall that is used for any purpose. No initial bedding will be provided. Shavings and feed will be available on the grounds.
5. Campers: Camper stickers will be given out at the show office and must be placed visibly in the window of the camper. Please take parking directions from the camper lot manager and see him if there are any problems.
6. Grounds Fee: Every horse entered will be charged a grounds fee of \$15 per horse.
7. Barn Rules: Please keep aisleways clear for horses & people. All manure must be disposed of in the bins provided by the fairgrounds or there will be a \$100 fine assessed to the person involved. Any sharps used must be disposed of in the hazardous waste buckets that can be found in each barn. Please do not leave sharps in the stalls or put them in trash cans — this poses a danger to the barn cleaners. All AQHA rules regarding humane treatment of horses must be followed.
8. Refunds: Stall money will be refunded only if stall is re-sold. No other refunds will be made.
8. Showing From Trailer: Only halter, barrel, reining horses and horses showing in The Collection classes may be shown from trailers or vans parked in the designated area. Trailer fees for horses not renting a stall are \$25 per horse per day. No horse can be left overnight in a trailer or van.
9. Splitting Classes: Novice flat classes will be split if there are more than 16 entries in the class. Open, Youth, Amateur and Select flat classes will be split if there are more than 20 entries in the class. For Hunter Hack classes that are over these numbers, the fences portion will be held and the top entries will come back for the flat portion.
10. Checks: There will be an NSF charge of \$50 for all checks which are returned for Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF). Checks will be deposited upon receipt. Checks should be made payable to Empire State Quarter Horse Association or ESQHA. All checks must be payable in U.S. Funds.
11. Class Schedule: Show management reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show. Show management also reserves the right to add or vary the list of Officials, if necessary, according to AQHA rules.

12. Coliseum Schooling & Longing: The Coliseum schooling schedule is listed in the class program and will be posted on the grounds. Longing areas will be available in the ring behind the Main Barn, in the area behind the Swine and Goat barn, and in the 4-H area only. Other than Yearling Longe Line horses during their warm-up time, there is to be no longing in the Coliseum.
13. NSBA Longe Line and NSBA 3 Year Old classes are open to all stock breeds and are subject to NSBA rules. Dual approved AQHA/NSBA classes are only open to horses registered with AQHA. In NSBA only classes, 85% of entry fees will be jackpotted. The jackpotted amount will be combined with Added Money and paid according to the NSBA schedule, rules 65-70 of the current NSBA Rule Book. Dual approved classes will not have paybacks. Scratches from NSBA classes will be charged the NSBA sanction fee.
14. The Hunter Jackpot Warm-up class can be ridden only one time. The class will be jackpotted with 50% of the entry fees being split by the top three winners under each judge. The suggested split is 46% — 31% — 23%, but the split may change based on the number of horses entered in the class.
15. The \$500 Collection Working Hunter Classic is open to all breeds. This class is to be shown over a course of fences 2'6" to 2'9". The top 12 to 15 scores from the first round will return to jump a second round over an adjusted course. Out of each entry fee paid, \$10 will be added to the \$500 added money and paid out as 1st—35%, 2nd—22%, 3rd—14%, 4th—11%, 5th—9%, 6th—9%. Additional prizes will be awarded to 8th place.
16. The \$500 Collection Hunter Under Saddle Classic is open to all breeds. The class will be shown on the flat, hand gallop optional. The top 12 to 15 scores from the first round will return to jump a second round over an adjusted course. Out of each entry fee paid, \$10 will be added to the \$500 added money and paid out as 1st—35%, 2nd—22%, 3rd—14%, 4th—11%, 5th—9%, 6th—9%. Additional prizes will be awarded to 8th place.
17. Small Fry Classes: Open to exhibitors 10 years of age and younger — walk-trot only.
18. Leadline: Open to exhibitors 7 years of age and younger.
19. Prize Money: All non-NSBA prize money will be paid in the office. Any prize money not picked up will be forfeited. NSBA checks will be mailed within 30 days following the show. No NSBA prize money will be awarded without a Social Security Number on file.
20. Circuit Awards: All circuit awards or other awards given out must be claimed at the horse show. No awards will be shipped. Management may limit the number of All Around or High Point prizes given to one horse.
21. Health Requirements: A New York State Inspector Veterinarian will be in attendance at the horse show. All horses must meet the following health requirements. New York horses must present a negative Coggins test dated 2009 or 2010. Horses stabled outside New York must present a negative Coggins test dated within one calendar year and a current health certificate. Please attach a legible copy to your entry form along with a current health certificate dated within 30 days of your arrival at the show grounds. All horses must show a current Rabies inoculation certificate.
