From the East or West: From the New York State Thruway (I-90), take exit 39 (Route 690). Follow Route 690 East to Exit 7 (Fairgrounds / Route 297). At the end of the exit, stay right onto Route 297. Make an immediate left turn into Fairgrounds Gate 2.

From the North or South: Follow Route 81. Follow signs to exit on Route 690 West and exit Route 690 at the Fairgrounds (Exit 39).

2010 Empire Fall Show

General Information

1. Move in / Move Out: Horses cannot arrive prior to Noon on Tuesday, September 20 and must move out no later than 9:00 a.m. on Monday, September 26.
2. Payments: One Fee Package Deals, individual stall fees & Camper Fees must be paid when submitting reservations. Without payment, NO reservations will be accepted. Any entry scratched from a class and not reported to the show office will be charged the class fee. Scratches reported to the show office will not be charged the class fee.
3. Stalls: Stalls will be labeled with stall card when you arrive. No transfer of stalls or change of occupancy may be made without the approval of the show management. Exhibitors will be charged for the use of ANY stall that is used for any purpose. Shavings and feed will be available on the grounds—contact the Show Office. All horses must have a stall — no horse may be shown off a trailer.
4. Campers: Camper stickers will be given out at the show office and must be placed visibly in the window of your camper. Please take parking directions from the camper lot manager and see him if there are any problems.
5. Office Charge: Every horse entered will be charged a one-time, non-refundable Office Charge of \$15.
6. Barn Rules: Please keep aisle ways clear for horses & people. All manure must be disposed of in the bins provided by the fairgrounds or there will be a \$100 fine assessed to the person involved. Any sharps used must be disposed of in the hazardous waste buckets that can be found in each barn. Please do not leave sharps in the stalls or put them in trash cans — this poses a danger to the barn cleaners. All AQHA rules regarding humane treatment of horses must be followed.
7. Refunds: No refunds except with a vet certificate.
8. Splitting Classes: Novice flat classes will be split if there are more than 16 entries in the class. Open, Youth, Amateur and Select flat classes will be split if there are more than 20 entries in the class. For Hunter Hack classes that are over these numbers, the fences portion will be held and the top entries will come back for the flat portion.
9. Checks: There will be an NSF charge of \$50 for all checks which are returned for Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF). Checks will be deposited upon receipt. Checks should be made payable to Empire State Quarter Horse Association or ESQHA. All checks must be payable in U.S. Funds.
10. Class Schedule: Show management reserves the right to change the order of classes before or during the show. Show management also reserves the right to add or vary the list of Officials, if necessary, according to AQHA rules.
11. Coliseum Schooling & Longing: The Coliseum and Toyota Barn schooling schedules are listed in the class program. Longing areas will be available in the ring behind the Main Barn, in the area behind the Swine and Goat barn, and in the 4-H area only. Other than Yearling Longe Line horses during their warm-up time, there is to be no longing in the Coliseum.
12. NSBA Longe Line and NSBA 3&4 Year Old classes are open to all stock breeds and are subject to NSBA rules. Dual approved AQHA/NSBA classes are only open to horses registered with AQHA. In NSBA only classes, 85% of entry fees will be jackpotted. The jackpotted amount will be combined with Added Money and paid according to the NSBA schedule in the current NSBA Rule Book.

Dual approved classes will not have paybacks. Scratches from NSBA classes will be charged the NSBA sanction fee.

13. The \$1,000 Cazabu Farms Sweepstakes is an AQHA/NSBA class open to Quarter Horses only. The purse will consist of \$1,000 added money plus 85% of entry fees. Payouts will be made as per the NSBA rule book.
14. The Hunter Jackpot Warm-up class will be jackpotted with 50% of the entry fees being split by the top three winners under each judge. The suggested split is 46% — 31% — 23%, but the split may change based on the number of horses entered in the class.
15. The \$500 Collection Working Hunter Classic is open to all breeds. This class is to be shown over a course of fences 2'6" to 2'9". The top 12 to 15 scores from the first round will return to jump a second round over an adjusted course. Out of each entry fee paid, \$10 will be added to the \$500 added money and paid out as 1st—35%, 2nd—22%, 3rd—14%, 4th—11%, 5th—9%, 6th—9%. Additional prizes will be awarded to 8th place.
16. The \$500 Collection Hunter Under Saddle Classic is open to all breeds. The class will be shown on the flat, hand gallop optional. The top 12 to 15 scores from the first round will return to jump a second round over an adjusted course. Out of each entry fee paid, \$10 will be added to the \$500 added money and paid out as 1st—35%, 2nd—22%, 3rd—14%, 4th—11%, 5th—9%, 6th—9%. Additional prizes will be awarded to 8th place.
17. Small Fry Classes: Open to exhibitors 10 years of age and younger — walk-trot only.
18. Leadline: Open to exhibitors 7 years of age and younger.
19. Prize Money: Checks will be mailed within 30 days following the show. No NSBA prize money will be awarded without a Social Security Number on file.
20. Circuit Awards: All circuit awards or other awards given out must be claimed at the horse show. No awards will be shipped.
21. Health Requirements: A New York State Inspector Veterinarian will be in attendance at the horse show. All horses must meet the following health requirements. New York horses must present a negative Coggins test dated 2010 or 2011. Horses stabled outside New York must present a negative Coggins test dated within one calendar year and a health certificate dated within 30 days of your arrival. All horses must show a current Rabies inoculation certificate.
